## **HOLLYWOOD'S DIAMONDS IN THE ROUGH CAMP GUIDELINES**

- ◆ Due to the progressive learning curriculum, the same children should attend all week. Substitutions/exchanging one child for another mid-week or day-by-day is not permissible.
- ◆ If for any reason your camp needs to modify your attendance at/participation with the Diamonds' Summer Academy, please contact the Diamonds' Program Manager or Executive Director immediately to discuss and/or make proper arrangements.
- ◆ Diamonds' campers must have a completed and signed permission slip to attend camp. Without one, campers will not be permitted to ride on the Diamonds' bus or to attend the Summer Academy
- ◆ On the Thursday prior to your camp attending the Summer Academy, please send a list of all campers (full names, ages and shirt sizes) to Hollywood's Diamonds in the Rough, Inc. via email [WeShine@Diamonds-Golf.org](mailto:WeShine@Diamonds-Golf.org) or by fax at 954-967-4221. Having this information ahead of time allows for a smoother experience for the campers (grouping the children and transitioning them from the van).
- ◆ Counselors must have the children ready for pick-up at your facility by/before 8:30 a.m. for the morning session and by/before 12:30 p.m. for the afternoon session.
- ◆ It is expected that one (1) counselor/per van travel roundtrip and remain with the children during the Summer Academy. If this is not possible, please contact the Diamonds' Program Manager.
  - Counselors are to remain with the children to not only keep them safe, but also to assist with bathroom breaks, first aid/emergency situations and disciplinary matters.
  - Camp counselors and/or Leaders-in-Training are NOT permitted to drive golf carts.
  - In case of an emergency, please make sure camp counselor(s) or the Diamonds Program Manager/ Executive Director are aware of who to contact at your respective camp.
- ◆ All camp participants must wear appropriate shoes – sneakers are preferred. For the safety of campers, sandals should be avoided.
- ◆ Campers must avoid bringing any personal items such as tablets, handheld games, headphones, equipment, jewelry, purses, wallets, toys, etc. to camp. We need campers to be and remain focused for the safety of all participants. Additionally, we cannot be responsible for the loss or damage of any of their personal items.
